Admission Directive

All admissions made are provisional and subject to approval of the Madurai Kamaraj University and Director of Government Examinations. The College has the right to cancel the admission made, if the documents submitted are found to be false or the qualification of the candidate admitted is not approved by the Madurai Kamaraj University. All admissions made are subject to verification of Mark Statement by the Director of Government Examinations and if the Mark Statement is found to be bogus, the admission is liable to be cancelled and criminal action would be initiated against the concerned candidate.

Concessions and Scholarship offered by Management

Concession in respect of Tuition Fees will be given to students admitted to any UG/PG Degree course who have got following marks in the qualifying examination

- a) 90% and above marks - 20% Concession
- b) 80% to 89% marks - 10% Concession

Single Parent Scholarship will be given at the discretion of the Management every year to students who have 90% attendance and passed in all subjects in the previous semester.
