We, in collaboration with the Youth Red Cross of Mannar Thirumalai Naicker College, Madurai, organized a free one day dental checkup camp for abandoned women at the Association of Arulaham, Madurai on February 10, 2025.

A total of 50 abandoned women benefited from this camp. Following the checkup, it was identified that these women require further treatment in the following.

Provisional Diagnosis

- 1. Total no. of cases: 50
- 2. Generalized Chronic Periodontitis: 15
- 3. Patients with missing tooth: 12
- 4. Patients with Chronic dental caries: 8
- 5. Patients with Mal occlusion: 5
- 6. Patients with Poor oral hygiene: 10

Treatment has to be done:

- 1. Scaling
- 2. Filling of Caries
- 3. Extraction of Grossly Decay tooth
- 4. Replacement of missing tooth with RPD and FPD
- 5. Patient education programmes
- 6. Orthodontic Treatment
- 7. Regular dental check-ups and follow up.




