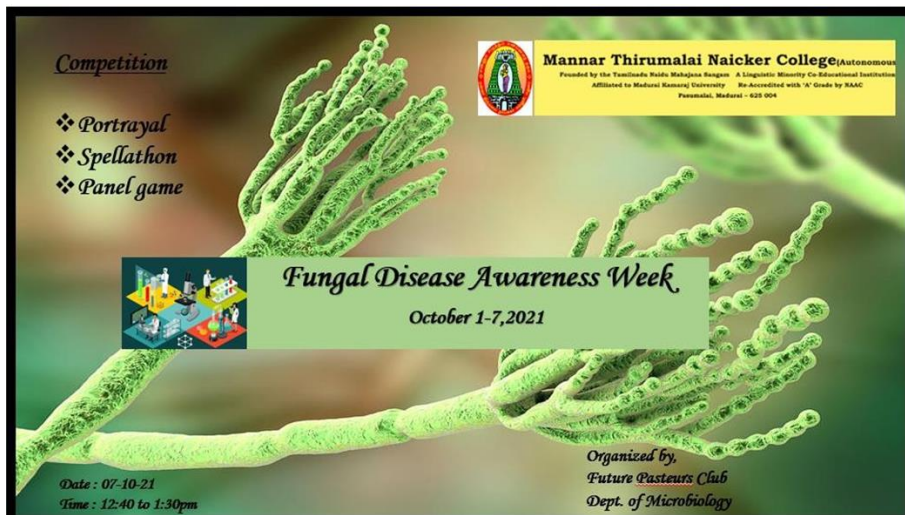

- ❖ **Panel Game**- Three rounds were conducted based Scientist Identification, Name of the Instruments and Fungal diseases.



Demonstrated on the following topics.


- The importance of hygiene to the food handlers
