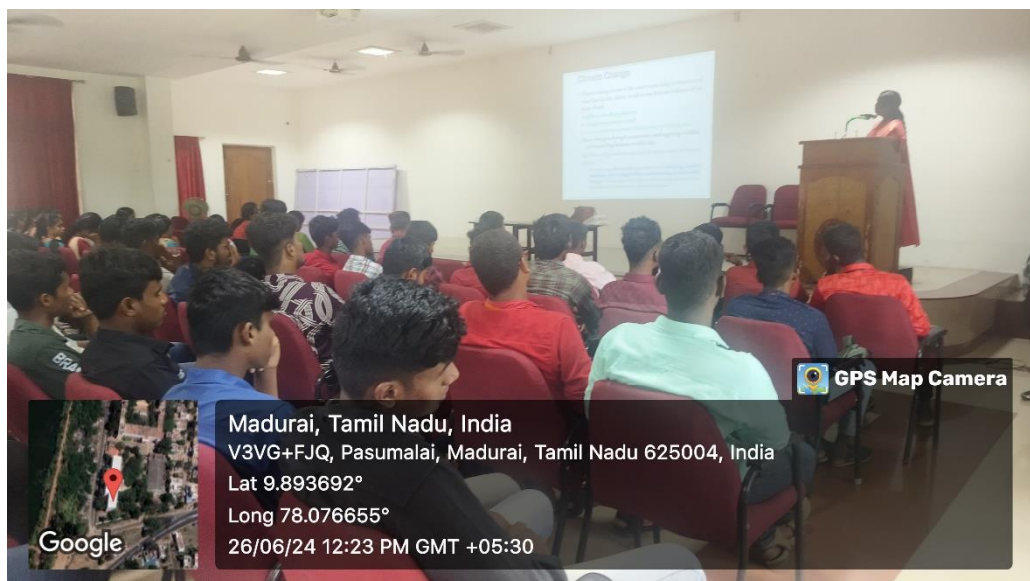

Report

The Department of Microbiology observed National Science Day on February 29, 2024, by organizing two guest lecturers for the students of Microbiology. The keynote speakers were Dr. P. Sundaresan – Senior Scientist, Department of Molecular Genetics, Aravind Medical Research Foundation [AMRF], Madurai and Dr. P. Varalakshmi, Assoc. Prof. & Head in-charge, Department of Molecular Microbiology, Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai.

The program started by 11:30am, with the welcome address delivered by III B. Sc., Microbiology student R. M. Karthika. The chief guests were introduced to the audience by Dr. T. Rohini, Asst. Professor and convenor of the program. The first session was delivered by Dr. P. Sundaresan, in which the speaker shed light on gene therapy, covering a vast area from basics to virus culture.

The second session started by 12:15am by Dr. P. Varalakshmi in which the speaker delivered a lecture on 'Fungal derivatives for non-communicable diseases', in which a wide range of topics including Advance Glycation End products [AGE], application of *Caenorhabditis elegans* in the treatment of non-communicable diseases, etc..., were covered.
