- ✦ All Staff meeting was conducted on 6th October 2021 and requested the head , staff and the offices of both the streams to furnish the data of the previous years to upload AQAR for the year 2020-2021
- ✦ All seven criterion conveners meeting with the members is convened on 20th, 21st 22nd and 23rd of October 2021 and discussed all the questions of AQAR and asked them to collect the data from the institution as per the new format introduced by NAAC.
- ✦ NIRF Portal was opened and pre-registration was done on 26th October 2021 and successfully submitted it on 15th November 2021
- ✦ All India Survey on Higher Education portal was opened on 29th November and successfully registered on the same day.
- ✦ Three volumes of hard copy were submitted to UGC for Extension of Autonomy for which UGC sent a communication for onsite visit to institution with expert committee list on 3rd of December 2021
- ✦ Based on the communication, all staff meeting was convened and requested all the staff to prepare the institution for autonomy visit.
- ✦ Autonomy review visits were held on 23rd and 24th December 2021 and the experts handed over a sealed report to the institution.
- ✦ The conveners meeting for seven criterions was held on 4th Tuesday and discussed the gray areas and further requested them to focus and fulfill the grey areas before the institution goes for re-accreditation in September 2022
- ✦ IQAC office was shifted to the Autonomy Block on 5th January 2022
- ✦ Dr.R.Sofia and Dr.A.Arivuchelvam, IQAC Members were assigned on 6th January 2022 to collect data and submit NIRF in the scheduled time.
- ✦ Submitted a SWOC analysis of the institution to the management on 28th January 2022.

- ✚ A meeting was held for functional heads, HoD's NSS Programme officers and Club convenors in the presence of the Chairman to carry out the suggestions by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell on 29th January 2022.
- ✚ Prof. D.Vimala was appointed as the additional coordinator of IQAC on 2nd February 2022.
- ✚ All staff meeting was convened to the staff of the self- financing streams to discuss the first and second criterions - IQAC requested the staff to speed up the work as per the requirement of NAAC as the institution has planned to go for re-accreditation on 4th February 2022.
- ✚ NIRF was successfully submitted on 11th February 2022.
- ✚ Curriculum revised meeting was organized to the staff of self-financing streams of Tamil, B.Com CA and Social Work
- ✚ All India Higher Education Survey (AISHE) was submitted on 24th Feb 2022.
- ✚ A Special meeting was conducted to the staff of self-financing streams to discuss the third & fourth criterions on 4th March 2022.
- ✚ An IQAC member meeting was conducted on 5th April 2022 and reviewed the uploaded data of AQAR before submission.
- ✚ AQAR was successfully submitted on 6th April 2022.
